Assignment Title: recruitment of an individual consultant (psychologist) and related services for staff members

The ECOWAS Commission has made provision in its 2024 budget to cover the costs relating to the above-mentioned mission.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include support to ECOWAS Commission staff, with a focus on promoting mental well-being, resilience, and coping strategies in the workplace environment.

The implementation period is 3 years renewable. The estimated start date is August 2024.

The ECOWAS Commission now invites eligible individual Consultants (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. Each experience or qualification must be justified by a certificate of completion, a work certificate, a copy of a contract, etc. The shortlisting criteria are:

- A minimum of 10 years’ experience as a licensed psychologist in providing psychological counselling or therapy services, preferably in a multicultural or international setting.
- Master’s degree or equivalent academic qualifications in psychology or a related field.
- Experience working with diverse populations and addressing a range of mental health issues.
- Experience in socio-cultural context of West Africa and familiarity with the challenges faced by professionals in an intergovernmental organization would be an asset.
- Language: Proficiency in one ECOWAS languages. Be comfortable in at least two (02) ECOWAS languages will be an asset.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section IV, paragraphs 1 to 5 of article 118 of the “ECOWAS Procurement Code”, January 2020 setting forth the ECOWAS policy on conflict of interest.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the **Individual Consultant Selection method** (IC) set out in the ECOWAS Procurement Regulations.
