- At least 10 years of practical experience in an FIU or FIU's operation, especially in analysis (financial intelligence generation and dissemination), 3 years of which should be at management level.
- Proficient in written and oral English, French or Portuguese, with analytic capacity, and strong report writing /drafting skills; and
- Well-grounded in the process and procedures of FIU's operations.
