TITIO TO DEVELOP A TECHNICAL GUIDE TO RELEVANT, SPECIFIC AND MEASURABLE MONITORING AND EVALUATION INDICATORS FOR EVALUATING ECOWAP PROGRESS AND RESULTS; ESTABLISHMENT OF RELIABLE AND HIGH-QUALITY DATA COLLECTION MECHANISMS TO FEED ECOWAP INDICATORS.

#### I. Context

The Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS), represented by the Directorate of Agriculture and Rural Development (DARD), plans to finance a mission from its 2024 budget to develop relevant, specific and measurable monitoring and evaluation indicators to assess the progress and results of ECOWAP. To carry out this activity, the ECOWAS Commission plans to recruit a consultancy firm to carry out the mission.

### II. Objectives

The main objective of this initiative is to improve the monitoring and evaluation (M&E) framework of the ECOWAS Agricultural Policy (ECOWAP). This initiative aims to support evidence-based decision-making, promote accountability and advance the sustainable agricultural development objectives of ECOWAS Member States.

#### III. Mission of the firm

The firm's main tasks are

- 1. Facilitate the development of a comprehensive technical guideline including relevant, accurate and quantifiable monitoring and evaluation (M&E) indicators for ECOWAP.
- 2. Put in place robust and reliable data collection mechanisms to support the ECOWAP progress report
- Propose a design for the dashboard of indicators specific to ECOWAP, in order to provide a succinct but comprehensive overview of the main performance measures and results.

## IV. Profile required of the firm

The firm must provide evidence of its technical capacity to undertake this assignment and meet the following conditions:

- Proven experience in developing and implementing monitoring and evaluation frameworks for agricultural policies and programmes
- Good experience in developing comprehensive technical guides and designing robust data collection mechanisms
- Mastery of methods for collecting, analysing and processing agricultural data
- Good facilitation and communication skills to liaise effectively with a wide range of stakeholders
- Have already developed at least two technical guides for indicators in a sector.
- A good knowledge of the socio-economic and agricultural environment in West Africa

Good experience of working in several ECOWAS member countries.
