Title: RECRUITMENT OF A FIRM TO ASSIST CERTAIN ECOWAS MEMBER STATES IN CONDUCTING AGRICULTURAL JOINT SECTOR REVIEWS.

I. Context

The Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS), represented by the Directorate of Agriculture and Rural Development (DADR), plans to finance a mission from its 2024 budget to support certain **ECOWAS member states in conducting joint sectoral reviews of the agricultural sector**. To carry out this activity, the ECOWAS Commission plans to recruit a consultancy firm to carry out the mission in the countries concerned under the supervision of the DARD.

II. Objectives

The main objective of this initiative is to strengthen the capacity of ECOWAS Member States to conduct effective and regular reviews of the agricultural sector, including Joint Sector Reviews (JSRs) and other relevant assessments, thereby ensuring the continuous improvement, accountability and transparency of agricultural policies and programmes in the region.

III. Mission of the Firm

The firm's main tasks are

- 1. Conduct thematic studies to conduct a joint sector review or evaluate the sector.
- 2. Facilitate the joint sector review process or any other evaluation process.
- 3. Review progress on development results
- 4. Review the performance of the agricultural sector
- 5. Review policies, programmes, institutions, and implementation processes
- 6. Review links, the enabling environment and assumptions
- 7. Strengthening the capacity of countries to organize reviews and assessments

IV. Profile required of the firm

The firm must provide evidence of its technical capacity to undertake this assignment and meet the following conditions:

- Experience in joint sector reviews in the agricultural sector.
- Experience in policy formulation, programme evaluation and strategic planning in the agricultural sector, particularly in West Africa, will be highly valued.
- Experience in analysing progress on development outcomes
- Experience in analysing the performance of the agricultural sector
- Strong ability to conduct in-depth thematic studies, analyse complex data sets and synthesize the information into usable recommendations
- Advanced skills in monitoring and evaluation and strategic planning.
- Extensive experience in the agricultural sector in the ECOWAS region, with a strong understanding of regional challenges and opportunities.
- Proven experience in engaging and collaborating with a wide range of stakeholders, including governments, development partners, non-state actors, the private sector, farmers, and researchers.
- Good knowledge of the socio-economic and agricultural environment in West Africa
- Good experience working in several ECOWAS member countries.

V. Selection criteria

Applications will be assessed based on the following evaluation criteria and scoring scales:

The minimum qualifying score is 70 points out of 100.

NB: the prerequisite and mandatory conditions to be met are the presentation of certificates of service rendered concerning the execution of similar contracts relating to activities, studies, and/or exercises connected with the assignment. Similar services not supported by legible copies of the cover sheets, signatures of the contracts performed, and certificates of successful completion will not be considered in the evaluation.

VI. Selection method:

The selection method is **Consultant Qualification**.

VII. Duration

The total duration of the consultant's assignment is 30 working days over three (3) months from the date indicated in the notification of the service order for the start of the assignment.

- Copies of contracts or certificates for previous services.
- Up-to-date administrative documents from the firm
